Head Coach (swimming - Denmark)

Swim Club Kalundborg has a vacant position as head coach.

The head coach has the following main areas of responsibilities

- Physical and technical training of the K1 and K2 team. Eight training sessions a week (three morning sessions and five afternoon sessions).
- Additional dry land training:
 - Weight training (in the local weightlifting club VK Esbern Snare).
 - Injury preventive training.
- Coaching role for other – mainly young – swim coaches in the club.
- Planning activities: competition planning and training camp planning.

Additional information and expectations

- The swim training on daily basis has to follow newest methods and principles, and Swim Club Kalundborg expects that our new head coach proactively seeks information in this area.
- The K1 and K2 team in the club mainly consist of competition swimmers age 11 to 18.
- The head coach is a permanent member of the K-swim committee. The K-swim committee manage administrative and practical tasks with regard to season planning, training camp planning, Novo Nordisk Swim Cup, sponsorship management etc.
- Eight weeks of holiday per year.
- Swim Club Kalundborg will assist in finding housing facilities nearby the training centre.
- For non Danish candidates Swim Club Kalundborg will provide basic training in Danish language.
- Possibility to combine the head coach job with educational activities or second job during daytime.
