## Regulations

### I. TIME, PLACE PROGRAMME

**Place:** Anykščiai 25 m pool “Bangenis”, Ažupiečių st. 1A.

**Date:** 13 – 14 December, 2018

**Organized by the Anykščiai sports center**

Boys born in: 2003 – 2004, 2005 – 2006

Girls born in: 2004 – 2005, 2006 – 2007

## II. ENTRIES

1. Technical entries must be submitted by no longer than **24:00 December 7, 2018**.
2. Changes/withdrawals will be accepted until **15:00 December 11, 2018**
3. Late entries will be accepted from 24:00 December 7, 2018, to 15:00 December 11, 2018. The fee is 15 €/ event.
4. Extra event (not applicable to changes and withdrawals) in reference to 2 is considered to be late entry.
5. No changes will be accepted after **15:00 December 11, 2018**.
6. Entries must hold doctor's visas allowing participation in competition. Team leaders are responsible for the valid allowances.
7. Entry times must cover the period from September 1, 2017 m. to December 11, 2018.
8. With entries you must submit the relay team entry. Only the teams who have submitted the relay team will be allowed to submit the named entries during the competition (must be submitted 60 minutes before the beginning of that competition part where the relay event will take place).
9. Each organization can have more than one relay team.
10. Entries may be submitted by „Entry Editor“ or Swimranking.net online.
11. All entries must be sent by e-mail: [anyksciaiswimmingfestival@gmail.com](mailto:anyksciaiswimmingfestival@gmail.com), by writing name of the team as file's title which suits swimrankings.net system code.

## III. COMPETITION

12. FINA rules are applied.
13. Time system „Alge timing“.
14. The swimming costumes and apparel must meet the FINA requirements.
15. The competition is held with heats and finals.
16. In 50 m, 100 m, 200 m events qualifications and finals (except for 400 m medley where only finals will take place). Finals will be held as following:
  - Final 1 – 6 places
17. Events with 6 participants or less will be held as a final in the evening session.
18. Relays: open group.
19. Before entering the race, the participant must register at the participants' judge in the call room. In case of not showing up, the participant will not be allowed to participate in the event.
20. For the finals, 2 reserve names will be announced; they must come to participants' meeting point. In case, one of the finalists does not show up, the reserve takes her/his place.
21. The written withdrawal from the final must be handed to the secretary no later than 30 min after announcing the results. Otherwise, the fine will be issued.

#### **IV. AWARDS**

22. The first three swimmers in each event will be awarded with medals and diplomas, in relays – only medals.
23. Three best teams, who will collect most medals in both age groups, will be awarded with cups or prizes.
24. The best six swimmers who will collect the higher amount of FINA points in three events sum total (only in the individual events) will be awarded with prizes.
25. If two or more swimmers collect the same amount of FINA points in three events, the winners will be announced according to the ranking he has in the first event (second, etc.)
26. If the athlete misses the awards ceremony, he/she will not receive the prize.
27. There might be extra prizes.

#### **V. PROTESTS**

28. Protests are allowed only against violations of competition rules and regulations as well as in situations where the competition or participants are endangered.
29. All protests must be submitted in writing with deposit of 50 €.
30. Meet's board of appeal will process protests according to the FINA rules.
31. In case of granted protest, deposit will be returned.

#### **VI. FINANCIAL TERMS**

32. Participation fee/person – 5 €, “late entry – 15 €/event.
33. The fee must be paid for all participants included into the protocol.
34. The fine for missing the heat – 5 €, final – 15 €, relay – 20 €.
35. All the expences (accomodation, trip) are covered by competitors or sending organization.
36. The expenses (accomodation, gathering) of main judges who are invited personally by Anykščiai sports center are covered by Anykščiai sports center.

#### **VII. FINAL STATEMENTS**

37. The Cup is a public event, where videos and photos might be taken.
38. The filmed and photographed material may be published in the media and online.
39. The team leaders are responsible for: following deadlines; the participants' safety during the arrival/departure and the competition; proper behavior of their athletes during the competition and the free time. By submitting application form participants agree to the Terms and Conditions of the Events.
40. Organizers keeps the right to make changes in competition date, time or programme if needed.
