I have the pleasure to send you the following information concerning the organisation of the **World Aquatics Coaches Certification Course – Assistant Coach Level (L1)** scheduled to be held in Riga, Latvia (LAT), from 21 to 23 April 2023. Please note the following information related to the World Aquatics Coaches Certification Programme and the coach's certification pathway:

Course description

- The objective of the World Aquatics Coaches Certification Programme is to promote sports' growth by offering a continuous learning pathway for coaches, providing, and setting the necessary competencies to complete the certification.
- The course will be delivered in English.
 The candidates must fully participate in all sessions of the course and complete all the required assessments.

Eligibility

- The World Aquatics Coaches Certification Courses Assistant Coach Level
 (L1) are open to all the National Federations interested in training and certifying their coaches.
- They are designed for those candidates with prior knowledge or coaching experience, preparing them for assistant coaching duties in swimming.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old at the start of the World Aquatics
 Coaches Certification Programme.
- Participants should have an intermediate level of English.











Registration

- Each National Member Federation may nominate coaches for this course.
 All participants must be registered by the <u>13 March 2023</u> in the <u>GMS</u> using your federation login details.
- Each profile must include the following information: personal data, photo, passport copy and the candidate's personal email address. Any application without all the above-mentioned information will be rejected.

Approvals

 World Aquatics will start to approve the registrations once the required number of participants has been reached (10). The approvals will be done on a first come first served basis and according to the priority for attendance established on the 2022-2025 Certification Pathway.

Assessment

- The official working language is English.
- For the written Face to Face exam, the use of interpreters, online resources and electronic devices is not permitted.
- In order to pass the course and become certified, a participant must pass
 the Online Course and the assessments available on the <u>Learning Platform</u>
 before the end of the Face-to-Face Course. In addition, he/she must
 attend the Face-to-Face Course and pass the examination.


Face to Face course:
